There's no more fumbling with power settings thanks to GE's smart microwave. Alexa integration works well there are many scan-to-cook options scanning to cook directions well run Smart features make the microwave a more intuitive App can have fresher power options at 0.9 cubic feet, its capacity is small There is not an easily accessible list of scanning products I do not know how to use my microwave oven, our friend who has a doctorate in electrical engineering recently admitted. I just warm things up for a minute, then if it's not done, add another minute. This recognition came when we explained that we were testing the GE Smart Countertop microwave oven. The device is connected to Wi-Fi, works with Amazon Alexa and has scanning technology. It all sounds pretty clever, but will it deliver a better Bagel Bite or save our friend from guessing how many times she has to press the button to add 30 seconds? Alexa microwave my coffee before you can take advantage of any of GE microwave smart tricks, you need to do some installation outside of the usual hooking it up and balancing the rotating plate on the perch. To set up your device on the Wi-Fi network, you'll have to download the GE Appliances Kitchen app (iOS and Android) and follow the instructions. You'll press the Wi-Fi Connect button in the microwave, connect to its network, and then connect it to yours. The Wi-Fi Connect button, which should not be used very often, is strangely located where we expect the Start button to work. Instead, the Start button is in the middle between the buttons connecting and stopping. It took some time for us to stop almost pressing the connection button when we were just trying to microwave some leftovers. Once the microwave is on your Wi-Fi, you can use it with Amazon Alexa devices if you have them. We recognize this: we did not read the instructions before the start. Previously, we connected the GE oven to our Echo Dot, so we assumed we would use the same Alexa Geneva skill for the microwave. After Alexa say: I'm not quite sure what went wrong and Darn, I'm a little confused, (same, Alexa, the same), we realized that we need another skill, U Connect . We're not sure what the difference is, except that we can just ask Alexa to control the microwave, instead of asking Alexa to add 30 seconds or whatever. Security features do not possibly include it when there is nothing inside. If asking Alexa to turn on the microwave sounds a little unreasonable, there are some security features. We had a mug of water sitting in the microwave while we tried to connect to the Echo Dot. When we asked Alexa for microwave coffee, the voice assistant replied: The microwave door has been inactive for too long. GE app Way installs a microwave to turn off and won't let you turn it on unless the door has been opened lately. This comes at the expense of a bit of convenience: If you want to stick a mug of water there at night and ask Alexa to heat it up when you wake up next it's not going to work. We're not sure if anyone would really want to do that, but it doesn't matter. You can't. A person must have a barcode besides integrating Alexa, the GE smart microwave also has a scan to cook. For a variety of products from Kraft, Amy's Kitchen, Campbell's and other brands, users can scan the product barcode and send cooking instructions to the appliance. We've got a list of over 2,900 snacks, soups, oatmeal and other products that work with the GE scanning app. Trying to shop through the list was a bit of a challenge. Heinz's fancy meal packaging Devour caught our attention in the case of frozen food, but when we cross-referenced the compatible GE list, only two out of six were available in the store. Meanwhile, a few who were in the store were not on the list. Bacon and mac with cheese it was. Another thing to keep an eye on is that GE also uses scanning to cook for some connected ovens. So while cake mixes, whole pizzas, and Toaster Strudel were on the list, they weren't microwave friendly. If there were no microwave instructions in the box, we left it on the shelf. (OK, well, we grabbed some Toaster Strudels to see what was going to happen, and the app told us the recipe wasn't found.) There was a nary core to be seen, but the popcorn was a little burned. We ended up making pasta, popcorn, chicken tenders, frozen broccoli and bagels of function pizza, with mixed results. The app shone with precise instructions for The Devour paste in the microwave - 3:30 minutes at altitude - that appeared on the box. We still had to push the start on the microwave ourselves. Then we were instructed to clean the film and mix the pasta. The microwave then set itself for another two minutes of the microwave, just as the window charged. The strange thing is that these instructions are for a 1100-watt microwave, while the GE microwave is only 900 watts. It's a bit amazing, the scanning to the cook feature doesn't take that into account and make adjustments. To be fair, our pasta eventually evenly heated throughout. We are willing to bet most people don't know by hand how to adjust cooking time for their microwave if there is a power mismatch. Epicurus recommends adding 10 seconds at the time of cooking the recipe for each 100 w above your appliance. If the microwave oven is more powerful, split the power of the recipe on yours, shift the decimal two places to the right, and set your machine to that power. All that math, why would it be nice if the machine did it for you. However, it's good that if you have an Echo device, you can ask Alexa to microwave at 70 percent power for three minutes rather than fumble with buttons. Jenny McGrath/Digital Trends GE microwaves do not always follow the packet instructions to the letter. For our frozen broccoli, the app recommended we add two tablespoons of water, while the bag did not mention H2O at all. Our bagel bites had to be microwaved on a high for two minutes and 10 10 Per box, but the app set the microwave to 50 percent power and rotates them for five to six minutes, according to the app. While they weren't universally crispy at the bottom, they were the best microwave bagel pizzas we had. One of the disconcerting features was the notifications. It was one thing for them to pop up as we waited for our broccoli to finish, but another when we were out of town and were notified that our microwave was done. We really didn't have to know every time our spouse heats the water for tea, thank you very much. You can disable notifications, but getting there is not very intuitive. You have to click on the microwave icon in the app and then click on the menu button from the next screen. Pop off For the final scan before the chef test, we decided to pop the popcorn and pit it against Alexa. The app followed the bag's instructions - which, hilariously, warned us not to use our microwave popcorn button. Oh. Instead, he put the microwave on a high for four minutes and then instructed us to listen and stop it when popping slowed down. We did it in almost two minutes. There was a nary core to be seen, but the popcorn was a little burned. Next, using another package from the same box, we asked Alexa for microwave popcorn. She wanted to know how much he weighed, so we fumbled around for the box. 3.2 ounces, we told her. She didn't understand us. After some back and forth, we stopped at 3 ounces and she turned on the microwave around 1:47. There were about 20 kernels at the bottom of the bag, but the popcorn itself was golden and unburned. We were ashamed of ourselves. Aside from the scanning function to the chef, the GE app doesn't have much, which is a missed opportunity. The microwave itself has all the usual buttons, including the apparently useless popcorn setting. But it would be useful if the application went beyond barcodes. Microwaves are great for cooking fresh vegetables, but we'll be darned if we know how long to make asparagus. If we could use the app to indicate what type of food we make and how much, we probably wouldn't have to suffer through soft vegetables again. Guarantee This GE microwave oven has a one year limited warranty. Our take for \$139, the GE Smart Countertop microwave has so many features. Alexa voice control and scanning to cook technology can be really useful for people with vision problems. We're guessing that a lot of people change the level of power in the microwave about twice a year, and anything that makes it more intuitive is good. We would like to see a more robust app that includes fresh food as well as more customized scanning instructions to the chef that actually take into account the lower power of this Furnace. What are the alternatives? Whirlpool also has a scan for microwave cooking, but it's \$639. It's over-range instead of a countertop, and its capacity is 1.9 cubic feet instead of the 0.9 cubic feet of GE. The Whirlpool model also uses convection cooking, so How long will it last? One good thing about smart appliances is they can get software updates with new features. Because they are related, manufacturers can also diagnose problems more easily. That being said, the scanning to cook feature will remain useful just as long as food brands are willing to support it. Should you buy it? Right now, the smart features for this GE microwave are very packaged-food oriented. If your diet revolves around ready-made soups, frozen dishes and popcorn, you may find the scan function to cook useful. This could potentially help those with visual impairments as well. We'll still be waiting to see if GE strengthens the app to include more fresh food content if it's your (home) jam.
